John Pittard Memorial Trophy (Singles Match Play)

This event is named after a Life Member, Vice President, Handicapper and VGL Councillor. This is a singles match play competition played over a series of months. Both players are equally responsible for coordinating the match.

Qualifying Round: All competing members play a qualifying Stableford round (refer Fixture) for the selection of the 16 players who will compete for the trophy. Players may elect not to compete for the trophy, in which case the next highest qualifier will be offered the spot.

Scheduling: Subsequent rounds are handicap match play stroke rounds which must be played on or before the date set out in the Fixtures Schedule by mutual agreement. If the match is not played before the due date and only one player is available on the due date, that player is the winner by forfeit. If neither player is available on the due date, and the match has not been played beforehand, both players are disqualified.

Match play events need not necessarily be played on the Sandringham Golf Links or be played on Saturdays. It is not necessary to return a scorecard. Advice by email (preferably) or verbally is sufficient.

In the event that a player is not able to play in the first round the next highest available qualifying member will be substituted until there are 16 qualifiers.

If there are any delays in the selection of the 16 players, the Match Committee will review the completion dates and post them in the competition room and update the Fixtures Schedule on the website.

Tie Breaking by Agreement: Refer to the same rule under the Ian Fraser Memorial Trophy (Pairs Match Play) event.
