STROKE INSTRUCTIONS

Most Stroke events are decided by the lowest Nett score, although the club champion for each handicap grade is based on the lowest Gross score at Sandringham.

To calculate your Nett score in a stroke event you add the total of your Gross strokes for the 18 holes and deduct your Daily Handicap.

Whatever your handicap, you should be aiming to score a minimum of nett par for the 18 holes.

The competition is won by the player who completes all holes with the lowest Nett score.

For handicapping purposes, you also need to calculate your Stableford points for each hole and show this on the scorecard.

EXAMPLES

If par for the course is 65 and a player with a handicap of 25 has 96 gross strokes, the nett score is 71 (96 less 25).
